

How to Use:

- 1. Carefully read the operating manual of your microwave oven for instructions for use with a thermometer.*
- 2. There is a protective cover over the thermometer tube. The cover should be used to pierce a hole in food. Be sure frozen food is entirely thawed before inserting the cover or thermometer.*
- 3. Unscrew and remove the cover to use the thermometer after using cover to pierce the hole. Insert thermometer in the thickest part of food.*
- 4. When used with meat, be sure to insert tip into the thickest part of meat to a point where it is past the center, but not in contact with bone, fat or gristle.*
- 5. Place food into microwave oven, leaving thermometer inserted during cooking.*
- 6. When thermometer reaches desired temperature, remove food.*
- 7. The thermometer will be hot!** *Use a heat-resistant glove when handling heated thermometer, containers and food.*
